This is the letter that was received by our President Linda Lunceford. It is addressed to the entire Kindervelt membership.

Dear Mrs. Lunceford,

We wanted to take a moment and convey our gratitude to you and all the wonderful people in Kindervelt for your continuing faith and commitment to Cincinnati Children's in general and to the Heart Institute in particular. Your ongoing gifts have catalyzed our ability to make transformational changes in cardiac care.

Your support of the Kindervelt Neurodevelopmental and Educational Clinic (NDEC) is particularly important as it has allowed a program that otherwise would not exist to flourish and show others the way. For children and adolescents with a history of heart disease, the NDEC is a unique resource, guide and, in some cases, a safe harbor. The specialized neurodevelopmental care that we are able to provide as a result of your gifts is unique for many reasons. 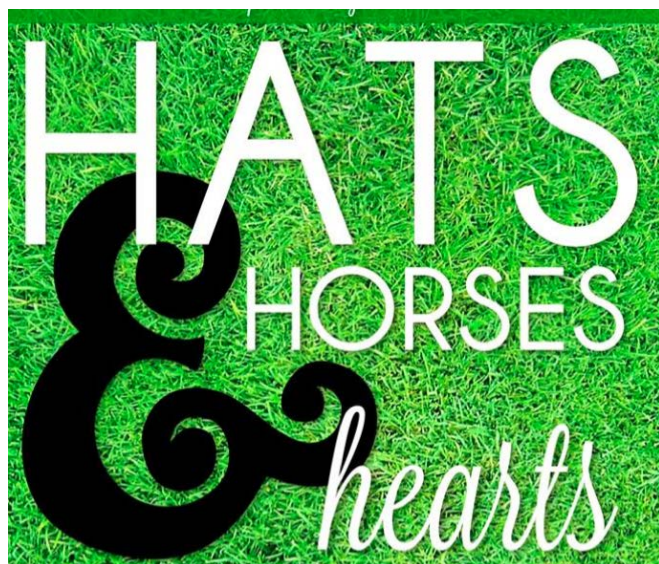
