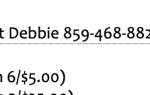

At our first Leadership meeting on September 9th, you will receive a paper packet of all the Kraft info in your group's mailbox.

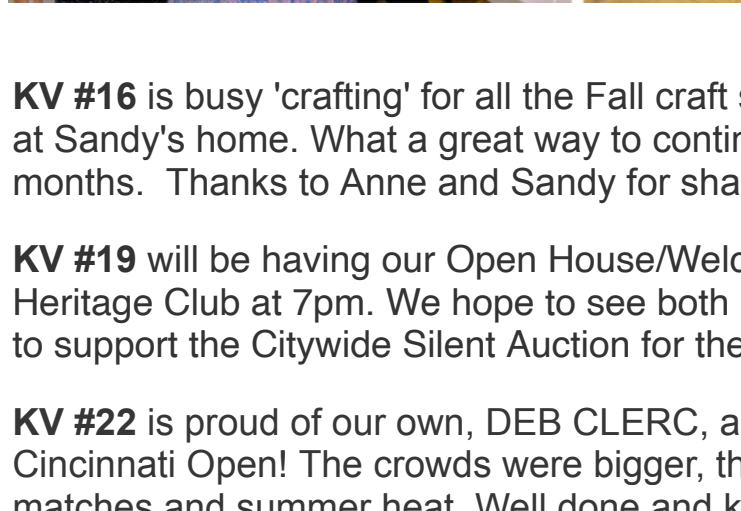
