If you prefer not to commit at this point but would like to be on the standby list to possibly cover last minute cancellations, please also contact me by text or email.

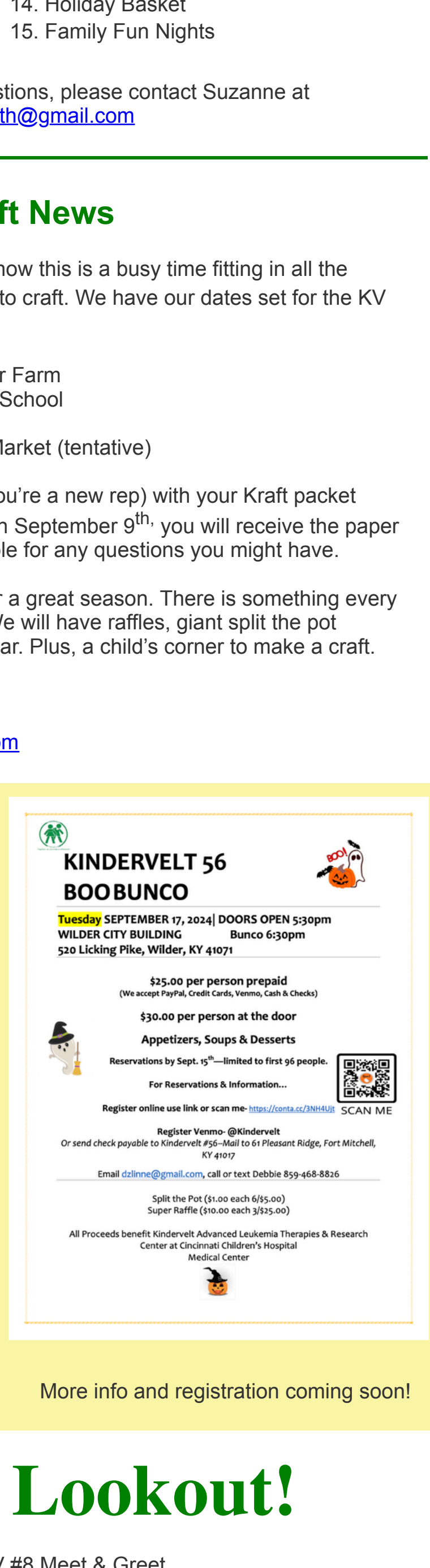

KV Kraft News

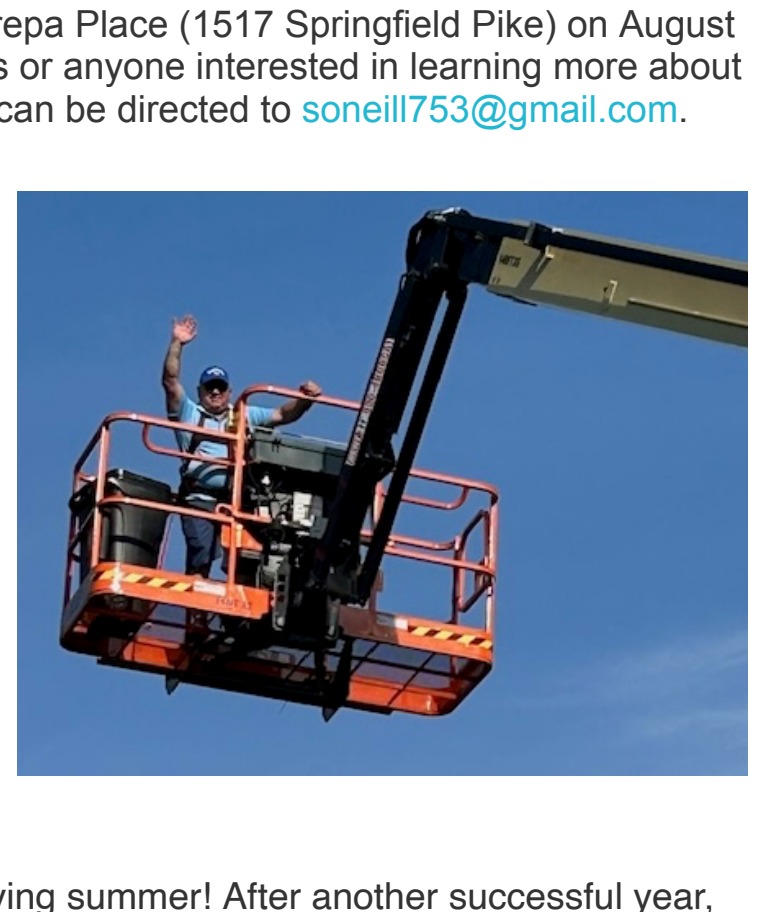
