KV PEACe Gratitudes

Dear Kindervelt,

Thank you for your generous support of Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center. My child has been treated by a long list of departments within the medical center, ranging from orthopedics to endocrinology. Our most extensive treatment and experience has been with the Division of Psychiatry.

My child began treatment for an eating disorder when he was 12 years old. He was treated on every level of care -- outpatient, inpatient and partial hospitalization. As his weight and heart rate plummeted to life-threatening levels, the treatment team wrapped their arms tighter and tighter around my child and our entire family. The doctors listened to our concerns and tried to reassure us the best they could. The nurses were gentle while drawing blood from his dehydrated and malnourished veins. The mental health staff was compassionate and supportive as they sat with us during every meal and snack.

In the course of treatment, it became clear that the eating disorder was a symptom of a larger concern. My child had Post Traumatic Stress Disorder as a result of abuse at the hands of family members. This disclosure rocked our family's world. But the CCHMC team gathered around us even more and guided us through the recovery process. My child required a higher level of care than even Cincinnati Children's could offer at this point. The social workers and RN care managers helped us find the right residential treatment centers that would be able to provide my son with the intense treatment he needed.

My son is now a healthy, happy 17-year-old. He excels academically and is involved in sports and extracurricular activities. By all accounts, he is a normal teenager even though the path that brought him to this point has been anything but normal. For this we are forever grateful to Cincinnati Children's.

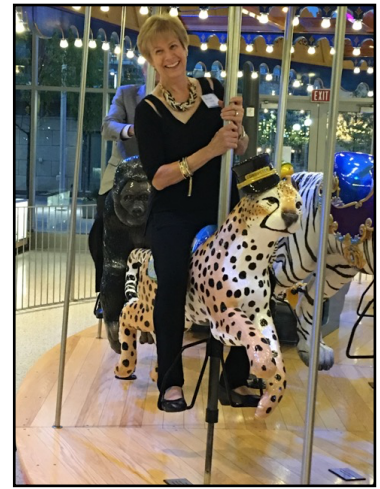




Member Profile

Mary Beth enjoying the carousel at 2017 Kindervelt Gala

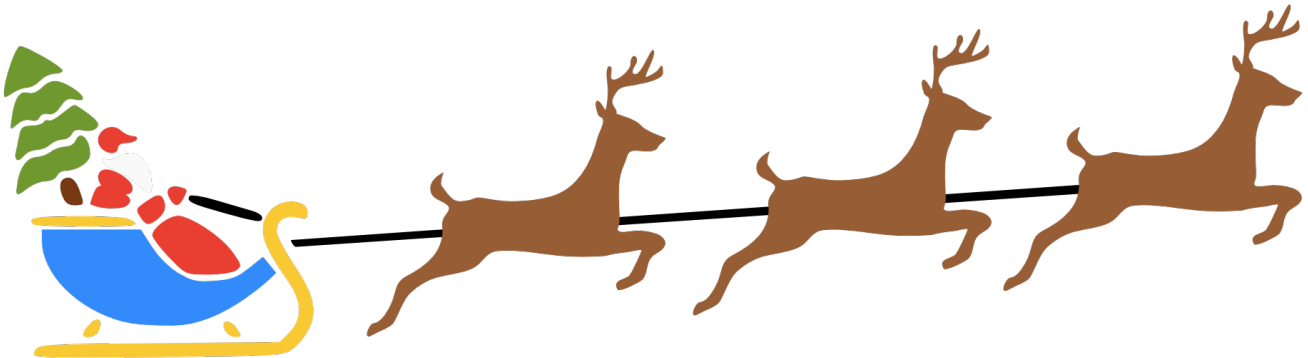
