Division Happenings...

Meet Joe Luria



In July 2017, Dr. Joe Luria assumed the new role at of Vice President, Mental Health Operations at Cincinnati Children's. The Division of Psychiatry is excited for Kindervelt to get to know Joe. We asked Joe a few questions about his background and new role at Cincinnati Children's.

Give us a brief career history:

I graduated from the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine in 1989. I completed my Pediatrics Residency at CCHMC in 1992, was Chief Resident in Pediatrics from 1992-1993, completed my Fellowship in Emergency Medicine from 1993-1995, and have been a practicing Emergency Medicine provider at Cincinnati Children's since 1998. In May I will celebrate 20 years of employment here at Cincinnati Children's Hospital. .

During my tenure at CCHMC, I served as Senior Medical Director in the Division of Emergency Medicine and then as Interim Division Director over a 9 year period. I then transitioned to a role in the Chief of Staff office as an Associate Chief providing support to our acute care inpatient units.

Why Mental Health:

I've always enjoyed the practice of Emergency Medicine. Since the emergency department cares for a large number of mental health patients, I started to understand some of the issues facing this patient population. It's hard not to be moved by some of the patients and stories I encountered. Clearly, our mental health care system needs to be improved to better serve our patients.

While in my role as an Associate Chief of Staff, I began working closely with the Mental Health care team, led by Dr. Sorter, and developed an even deeper passion for working with this patient population. I also saw the level of passion the staff have towards serving the mental health patient population. It's hard not to want to be part of that team in improving mental health care. When the VP role became available it felt like a natural fit, so I applied for the position.

The position itself was developed by the leadership at CCHMC to help address the growing needs of mental health care in the Cincinnati area.

How will you measure success of your time in this position – when you leave this role Psychiatry will be different in what way(s)?

I want to be a part of the team that is working to develop a care system in the region that can meet the needs of the patients we serve. Hopefully we can improve:

- Access to services
- Transitions from care back to family/school life
- Transitions between the hospital and community providers
- Better patient and family experience for families while they interface with mental health services at CCHMC.
- Better staff experience. Our staff work very hard to provide the best care possible. We need to make it easier for staff to deliver that care.

Honestly, Children's Hospital has always worked hard to deliver on all these things. I hope we strive to continually improve and do better in these areas.

Small things that make your day better:

For me, still being able to make a difference as a medical provider to patients in need. I still work in the Emergency Department here, and recently have been working as a provider for medical coverage at the College Hill campus in the evening.

Who inspires you to be better?

Hearing the stories from individual patients. When you begin to understand what our patients go through day in and day out and the hard work of our employees, it provides plenty of inspiration for wanting to create better outcomes for everyone.
